Workplace Green Up is an employee engagement program for Green Economy London members to provide employees with fun sustainability activities! All activities can be done both in the workplace and/or at home.

Members can earn points over the four weeks by completing different activities. Each week focuses on one of Green Economy London's target areas: waste reduction, GHG emissions reduction, water conservation, and environmental stewardship.

Week 1 - Environmental Stewardship: November 1st - 6th

Week 2 - Waste Reduction: November 7th - 13th

Week 3 - GHG Emissions Reduction: November 14th - 20th

Week 4 - Water Conservation: November 21st - 27th



In addition to empowering businesses to set and achieve sustainability targets, Green Economy London aims to embed sustainability in the work culture of our members. Whether the action is a small individual change or large organizational commitment, they all contribute to our mission of making London one of the greenest cities in Canada.

Please note that some Workplace Green Up activities may count as projects towards your organizational targets.



RULES

- 1. Distribute this Workplace Green Up material to employees and coworkers.
- 2. Email Allison at **allison@londonenvironment.net** to indicate that employees from your organization will be participating.
- 3. We encourage as many employees as possible to participate; however, only a minimum of **two** employees need to participate per organization.
- 4. Bonus point activities should be completed by November 30th.
- 5. Activities should be completed during their assigned weeks:
 - Environmental stewardship: Nov 1st 6th
 - Waste reduction and diversion: Nov 7th 13th
 - GHG emissions reduction: Nov 14th 20th
 - Water conservation: Nov 21st 27th
- 6. Points are tallied per organization, not individually
- 7. To earn points, share activities on Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, or Instagram. You **must tag Green Economy London** and use the hashtag **#WorkplaceGreenUp2022** to ensure we can track activity submissions.

100 POINTS - Use Environmentally Friendly Cleaning Products

Switch most or all current cleaning products to industry standard green certified products

100 POINTS - Screen an Eco Documentary or a Podcast

Watch a documentary, listen to a podcast, or read a book about an environmental topic, individually or as a team.

To earn points: Screenshot or share what your team listened to, watched, or read, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

250 POINTS - Outdoor Clean Up

Participate in a litter clean up in your community with staff or family members. Grab a bag and gloves and head out in your neighbourhood to pick up litter and help spruce up our city!

To earn points: Post a picture of the clean up, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

250 POINTS - Share Feedback on City of London Mobility Master Plan

The City of London has shared the Mobility Master Plan that will help to determine how London prioritizes transportation and mobility infrastructure, programs and policies for the next 25 years. Review the plan and share your feedback <u>here</u>.

To earn points: Post a picture of you reviewing the plan, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

500 POINTS - Make Your Space More Bird-friendly

Complete one of the following projects to make your office or home more bird-friendly

- DIY or retrofit your windows to prevent bird collisions
- Bird-safe lighting practices

To earn points: Post a photo of your project, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

500 POINTS - Green your Coffee Station

Source fair trade and bird friendly beans, reusable or compostable coffee filters, and eliminate disposable cups and individually packaged milk, sugar, and cream.

To earn points: Post a photo of the sustainable coffee station, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

Waste Reduction and Diversion

November 7th - 13th



100 POINTS - Switch to Zero Waste Cleaning Products or Hand Soaps

Switch cleaning products to refillables, this will reduce the amount of single use plastics sent to landfill.

To earn points: Post a photo of your refillable products, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

250 POINTS - Zero Waste Lunch Week

Encourage friends and coworkers to bring lunch and snacks in reusable containers, mugs, water bottles etc., using things like reusable cutlery and metal straws instead of single use food packaging.

To earn points: Post a photo of your zero waste lunches, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

250 POINTS - Attend Waste Not: Reducing Waste for a Sustainable Future Webinar

Attend the waste webinar happening on Wed. Nov. 9th, from 12-1pm for a virtual discussion on waste reduction strategies for consumers and businesses, and how addressing food waste supports resilient food systems, and a sustainable future.

Introduce an organic waste stream at home or work to reduce the amount of food waste from going to landfill.

700 POINTS - Perform a DIY waste audit

A waste audit can help your business determine the effectiveness of its current waste management strategies. Perform a waste audit and identify areas for improvement.

GHG Emissions Reduction

November 14th - 20th



100 POINTS - Power Down

When electronics are turned off but still plugged in they use 'standby' or 'phantom' power. Plug electronics into a power bar and turn the power bar off at the end of the work day and on weekends to reduce electricity use.

• Phantom Power: Hydro One

To earn points: Post a photo of your power bar turned off at the end of the day, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

100 POINTS - Adjust your Thermostat

It's recommended that you keep your space between 20°C – 22°C degrees in the winter when you're home, and 17°C – 19°C degrees when you're away or headed to bed for the night.

To earn points: Post a photo of your adjusted thermostat at home or work, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

250 POINTS - Share Greener Homes London Sustainability Guide

Share the Greener Homes London sustainability guide with colleagues and family. This guide provides guidance, tools, and resources for residents to create a more sustainable home.

500 POINTS - Insulate Electrical Outlets and Seal leaks around Windows and Doors

Electrical outlets allow air to pass through. Insulate all of your exterior wall electrical outlets. If you are feeling drafts, you can save up to 25% energy by sealing all leaks around doors and windows.

500 Points - Give Sustainable Transportation a Try

Bike, walk, bus, carpool, or drive your EV to work to reduce your transportation emissions!

Water Conservation

November 21st - 27th



A leaky faucet can waste more than 3,000 gallons a year! Check your workplace or home for dripping faucets and get them fixed.

To earn points: Post a picture of your faucets getting fixed, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

100 POINTS - Check For and Fix Leaks Outside

Outdoor faucets and hoses are common culprits for leaks outside your home or business. Check all outdoor faucets, hoses and joints to make sure there is no water loss.

To earn points: Post a picture of your faucets getting fixed, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

250 POINTS - Only Run Dishwasher and Washing Machine when full

It is more efficient to wash a full load of dishes than washing by hand. To maximize the water your machines are using, only run them when they are 100% full.

To earn points: Post a photo to show you're running the machines when full, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

250 POINTS - Research Landscaping Techniques and Low Impact Development Projects for Your Home or Business

Spend some time learning about landscaping techniques and low impact development (LID) practices that could be implemented at your home or business to help conserve water and manage stormwater. Here are some links to get you started:

To earn points: Post a photo and tell us about the projects you found to be most impactful and feasible for your business or home, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

500 Points - Add Aerators to Faucets

Adding aerators to taps will significantly <u>reduce flow rate while maintaining pressure</u>. These can be purchased at most home improvement stores. Look for an aerator with a flow rate of 1.5 gallons per minute or less.

To earn points: Post a picture of your newly installed aerator, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022

500 Points - Install a Rain Barrel

Installing a rain barrel under your home or workplace's downspout will reduce the amount of water used for watering landscaping and gardens. It also helps to reduce pollution caused by stormwater runoff.

To earn points: Post a picture of your newly installed rain barrel, tag Green Economy London and use the hashtag #WorkplaceGreenUp2022
